The Main School of Fire Service

The Main School of Fire Service (SGSP) in Warsaw is the only one in Poland and one of the few state technical universities in the world, which trains fire officers and educates specialists in fire safety and civil safety engineering. SGSP reports to the Minister of Interior and Administration and is scientifically and educationally supervised by Ministry of Science and Higher Education.

It has full academic rights and constitutes an organizational unit of the State Fire Service (PSP).

SGSP's history commences in 1919 as Central Technical Training School for Fire-fighters.

- Education and training of specialized staff for Polish National Fire & Rescue System as well as for self-governmental and governmental administrative organizations (e.g. Civil Protection Entities) on a higher educational/academic level.
- SGSP educates also specialists in fire and civil protection for commercial entities (e.g. refineries, power plants, breweries, etc.).
- Scientific and research activity in a range of fire and civil protection.
 SGSP employs about 150 didactic and scientific staff.



SGSP study program and research work is based on numerous laboratories.

- A multimedia decision making training (within Safety Research Department) on all managerial levels (interventional, tactical and strategic) including individual needs of trainees. Participation in it (virtual reality/role play training) allows the trainees to be more efficient during response operations for crisis situations in real life. Proper behavior and decision making process learned on the training causes an increase in effectiveness and decrease of potential negative effects of a crisis situation in reality.
- Since 2001 the training has been running for representatives of different levels of self-governmental and governmental administration and Polish National Fire & Rescue System (district, province, state level).
